MISS GLITTERMAN saved ground disputing the pace, shook clear in upper stretch and held sway. WHATASWEETHEART got out early then had her heels clipped by ZIPPY when pushed farther out nearing the completion of the first furlong and closed well. MEET MS BIRD rallied mildly to gain third. SMART FLOW broke a step slowly and responded well in the drive. DINNERAT FIVE got out causing crowding after the first sixteenth of a mile, chased and faded in the drive. BREADKNIFE failed to threaten. MOUNTAIN SEA broke alertly to vie for the lead outside the winner and tired. DOUBLE TALKIN showed little. ZIPPY was being checked in tight quarters when she clipped the heels of WHATASWEETHEART and fell after the first sixteenth of a mile. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the incident on the backstretch before the results were declared official.
