THREE DAY WEEKEND saved ground setting the pace and was not quite good enough for the winner. MISTER ROY (ARG) was forwardly placed and lacked the needed response in the stretch. CHANGING FUNDS made a run along the inside into the stretch then needed more. SETTEBELLO prompted the pace then weakened in the drive. THE LAUREL FOX tired from his early effort. SPOTLIGHT SCAM prompted the pace and tired. CATMANIA hopped at the start then was outrun.
