MARK VALESKI didn't break alertly then joined for the lead soon after the start to duel two wide and drew away under steady handling. ANCIENT ROME vied for the lead along the inside rail then was second best in the final furlong. COLOR CAM moved up along the inside into the stretch to gain the show. BARTOW failed to menace with inside bid in the stretch. GOLDEN SUCCESS broke sharp and showed early speed outside horses then weakened. WINONEFORTHEZIPPER chased the top two to the stretch then weakened. BAREFOOT MAILMAN showed early speed then tired. GOTOGO BYE tired.
