MEGA BOOM was away alertly and well placed along the inside rail then moved through inside the pacesetter in the final furlong and got up for the decision. I. E. FLASH broke alertly to set all the pace then was not quite good enough late. MOONSTOCK was well placed just off the pace then finished willingly. GOLD MAN promoted the pace from the outset and gave way grudgingly. BEN'S BONUS was unhurried early then rallied mildly in the final quarter mile. PRESIDENTAL COLORS lacked the needed closings response. IRUNALATTE flattened out in the drive. PROMISED DESTINY tired from his early effort. UPPER AFLEET's saddle slipped on the first turn then he was pulled up.
