DOE RUN broke alertly to set the pace into the final furlong then weakened. SCARLET'S NUMBER prompted the pace then lacked the needed rally. MARIE'S BABE raced in a bit of traffic along the inside in the final furlong. VENTANIA broke in a tangle then failed to threaten. MISS SEDUCTION showed little. RACYN WITH GRACYN was outrun.
