NATIVE WAVE moved closer along the inside around the far turn, was sent up outside the leader in midstretch and won under strong handling. KATRINA'S PRINCE, away alertly, made a run into the stretch and finished gamely to close the gap. CONCORDE EXPRESS broke alertly, saved ground setting the pace then was not good enough. TRUE TEST was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap. TIME FOR TUTT made a run on the far turn then lacked the needed closing response. SEEKING ROMANCE was unhurried early then rallied mildly in the final quarter mile. I'M NOT WHO I WAS prompted the pace to the far turn then weakened. WINTER'S COMING tired from his early effort.
