DERBY DAY RALLY prompted the pace along the inside, eased out in upper stretch and ran down the leader in the final furlong but drew clear late. FIREHOUSE AFFAIR broke alertly to set the pace and held on stubbornly to the end. MARK AIM FIRE moved closer into the stretch and loomed boldly through the stretch but lacked the needed closing response. SEASONS PROMISE moved up wide around the turn then lacked the needed closing response. INVALIDATE prompted the pace and faded in the final furlong. CANNON IN G failed to threaten. VOLHYNIA was outrun. SEMINOLE GAL broke in a tangle then was outrun.
