WORTHY WAGER was hard to load, set a slow pace, shook clear in the drive then just failed to last. FERBER made a middle move, got through inside in the drive and was gaining on the top two late. WHISKEY MAN pressed the pace three wide to upper stretch then weakened. ANDY L passed tiring rivals. CARSON'S HAWK was through after a half. VICAR IN THE HOUSE was no factor. MISTER ROY (ARG) showed little. REFUGE failed to menace.
