Footnotes

DIAL DIRECT raced close up early, bid into the second turn then drew off steadily after six furlongs when asked. MISS PAVAROTTI stalked the pace early, bid after five furlongs but was no match for the winner while second best. CASTLE CREEPING was void of early speed then lodged a mild rally late. ECONOMIC STIMULUS set a moderate pace early then faded. MON CHOU was through early.
