BLOOMINGTON SNOOKS dueled for almost five furlongs with JORDAN'S PRINCESS then drew off late under brisk handling. The latter disputed the pace with the winner to near the furlong marker before weakening but was best of the rest. SCHATZ (PER) advanced inside on the turn, swung six wide for the drive and lodged a mild bid late. FIVEBLUSHINGROSES stalked the pace to the stretch, angled out for the drive then failed to respond. LADY DEVILLE passed tiring rivals. LA CATIRA, well placed for a half, gave way. JACKIE FAWCETT gradually weakened. BAILEY CORNER ROAD was no factor. CRISTAL MIST was through early. TRICIA'S BANNER was wide to the turn. VIRGINIA D showed little. WHATSA MANOR MONA stopped.
