OCEANOGRAPHY moved closer leaving the far turn then ran down the leader in deep stretch and prevailed. REINSTATEMENT, well placed along the inside rail, loomed boldly in the final furlong to gain an advantage but was outfinished. OTTOWISE was eased back after a quarter and rated close up then lacked the needed closing response. PERSONAL EDGE was well handled showing the way then gave way grudgingly. FALL SEMESTER made a run leaving the far turn then lacked the needed closing bid. HAWAII CALLS showed little. DARNED BIRD lacked a rally. WILD SCENT was through early and was pulled up in distress entering the far turn.
