COMPLETE ST. raced close up along along the inside then finished gamely to just miss. ARCHERETTE moved up two wide on the far turn, loomed boldly through the stretch but was outfinished. WAR RELIC closed outside rivals in the final furlong and was checked around the fallen rival in deep stretch. MELA DRAMATICALLY closed outside rivals in the final furlong and was checked around the fallen rival in deep stretch. FUNNY LADY moved to the inside when clear early to set the pace then faded in the final furlong. PASKHA moved closer around the far turn and ran down the leaders in the final furlong then broke down and fell in deep stretch. A stewards inquiry was conducted into the stretch run
