FOUR STAR MORNING chased the winner inside, couldn't gain on that one but was best of the rest. RUN MARIA RUN made a three wide middle move to contention but failed to sustain that rally. VIRTUOUS LASS was off slowly then passed tiring rivals. HERE COMES CHERRY was no factor. BRIT KAY showed little. TIME TO LISTEN was through early. FLEET QUEEN chased the winner outside then stopped.
