SKIPPIN' BABE pressed the early pace while carried wide by BORDER FIRE, continued gamely to gain a short lead in the furlong grounds then was fully extended to prevail over EMERY BOARD. EMERY BOARD was wide early, angled inside to stalk the pace, attempted to get through along the rail passing the quarter pole but was forced to altered course three wide when BORDER FIRE dropped to the rail then after looming boldly leaving the furlong grounds, hung late. BORDER FIRE was very wide entering the backstretch, remained off the rail to the second turn where she dropped over the rail then continued well through a prolonged drive before also hanging late. TACTICAL PUNCH made a middle move to be in striking position into the stretch then lacked a strong late response. WEEKEND GOLD raced evenly. AUNTIE ADELE stalked inside to the second turn then faded. LAUREN'S TOUR was through early. EXONERATING showed little.
