FUR LINED raced close up for a half, bid leaving the turn then slowly pulled away under pressure. JEANNIE S set a solid pace, slowly weakened in the drive but saved the place. HIGH CRY stalked the pace early, bid four wide out of the second turn then flattened out. RAIDERS FAN checked and steadied along the inside through the first turn. WRITE WHEN READY chased for five furlongs then faded. BALTIC LADY broke in the air. PAR LADY showed little. SAFE N RICH was no factor. KISSAMEE GLITTER stopped.
