CHECK POINT advanced along the inside on the far turn then came out for the drive and ran down rival in time for second. ALL NIGHT LABOR broke alertly to set the pace then was not quite good enough late. SEA WIND was away alertly to be forwardly placed then faded in the drive. TAMMY'S VICTRESS bobbled at the start, prompted pace to the far turn then weakened.
