CAPE GIRL broke sharp and saved ground setting the pace then turned back the challenge of COMPLIMENT TREE in the final furlong and edged clear. COMPLIMENT TREE prompted the pace, loomed boldly in upper stretch but was not good enough. K ONE KITTY raced within easy striking distance for six furlongs then weakened. MISSBAUER failed to threaten. TIMBER LANE was forwardly placed outside rivals to the far turn then tired. SUPER HEROINE showed little. RUN FOR SHELTER tired. SHEZOUTAHERE raced close up along the inside to the far turn then tired.
