

Footnotes

JOSTLE allowed to settle, made a four wide move through the second turn to challenge, dueled to deep stretch before drawing clear late. DISCO DARLIN' stalked the early pace, bid 1/4 pole, held a short lead into the final furlong then hung but saved the place. HIGH CODE fanned four wide, finished well late. VALLEYDAR sprinted clear then weakened in mid stretch. ECO ALFA bid second turn then flattened out drive. FIESTY COUNTESS well placed to 1/4 pole, gave way. PRINCESS HA HA was no factor. LADY DORA failed to threaten. REGAL BROAD was in tight first turn.
