BANAMI MA ME made a run on the far turn but was no match for the winner and finished second best. TEN SOMETHING bobbled at the start, advanced along the inside into the stretch for third. WATCH HER PUNCH prompted the early pace and tired. SONG OF NORA broke alertly to set the early pace then tired. STRIKEAPROMISE tired. ANNETTOS PRIZE lacked a rally. SPLASH OF BRAT showed nothing. SAFE PASSAGE prompted the pace for a half mile and tired.
