TALKIN ROBYN, well placed close to the pace, loomed boldly in the final furlong and was second best. BIT OF ATTITUDE vied for the early lead, shook loose on the turn then faded in the drive. MINER'S MONSTER lacked the needed rally. MARYTWEET broke a step slowly, moved up to be forwardly placed then faded in the drive. BRIDGET OF EIRE weakened in the drive. PRESCRIBED GLORY showed little. TASHSAWI PROMISE was outrun. SIGNALS DIARY tired. PRINCESS GOOBER dueled for the early lead and faltered.
