STORMY DYNASTY unhurried early, was boxed briefly on the 2nd turn, got through inside to be up for place while no threat to the winner. COURTING DREAMS made a four wide middle move then lodged a mild rally. H. F. BRIMSTONE dueled to stretch then weakened. PIC A LIL pressed the early pace then faded. RISING EMPRESS stopped and was outdistanced.
