WON MORO moved to the lead between rivals in upper stretch and drew off under brisk urging. TOPPENISH made a run into the stretch and finished well to get up for second. PRINCESS GINA saved ground disputing the pace and faded in the final furlong. PUFF lacked the needed closing response. BELLE'S MISS broke alertly to dispute the pace and weakened in the drive. BLUSHING RED, void of early foot, failed to menace. ECONOMIC IMPACT was outrun. LITTLE MOUSE showed little. NUMBER PLEASE tired. RAY'S RAINBOW prompted the pace and faltered in the drive. GRECIAN COLORS tired. FINA ESTAMPA dropped far back.
