A PERFECT SQUEEZE made a run into the stretch then ran down the leader in the final furlong. GOVERNMENT BAILOUT rallied outside rivals on the far turn to challenge then gave way grudgingly. GLORIOUS NOTION, unhurried early, circled rivals on the far turn lacked the needed closing bid. COUNTINGONCAROLYNN closed outside rivals through the stretch. SMARTY SLEWY moved closer completing six furlongs then lacked the needed closing response. FRANSTEIN moved to the lead into the far turn then weakened in the drive. COVER UR HEART saved ground disputing the pace and tired. BRISK TIDE prompted the early pace and tired.
