CRACK THE BOOKS sprinted clear early to control the issue and was under steady handling to prevail. CARA'S LASSIE, never far back, finished willingly to close the gap and get up for second. LONESOME RIVER was outrun early then responded well in the drive to just miss for second. IMPERIAL WAGER chased the winner racing near the inside and was not quite good enough. SEMINOLE GAL rallied mildly. FIFTH AVENUE DOLL failed to threaten. IF I HAD moved up menacingly into the stretch then faltered in the final furlong. SILENT SCREAM prompted the early pace and tired. MADAM KIPPER was through early. SKIN DEEP showed nothing.
