MAGIC LION moved closer on the far turn then closed near the inside rail and drove clear in deep stretch. STRATEGIC HOPE quickly went to the front, turned back the challenge of WORTHY WAGER in upper stretch then couldn't withstand the winner. WORTHY WAGER moved up menacingly to engage for the lead three furlongs out then was not good enough. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE moved closer leaving the far turn then could gain little in the drive. SAIGON STORY broke alertly to be forwardly placed then flattened out. TRIPLE VISION tired from his early effort. PERUANO SMOKE showed little. CALDO CAT dropped back while being restrained from getting out into and around the first turn was eased.
