DIAMONDS FOR LIL vied for the early lead while well off the inner rail, drew off leaving the second turn then was ridden out to prove clearly best. BAILLIE'S BEAUTY made a middle move after five furlongs and was best of the rest. ONE BAD COYOTE made an inside middle move to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. TURN TRUE pressed the winner from the outside to the second turn then faded. RANDOM THOUGHTS was well placed for six furlongs but came up empty. SUFFIELD STAR failed to menace. CENTERTON MISS was through early. SEPTEMBER STORM stopped.
