CARNIE'S DANCER moved up four wide leaving the turn, gained the lead near the furlong pole then drove clear. PARTY TO PARTY advanced three wide to challenge leaving the turn and gave way grudgingly. GRISHAM, outrun early, finished well to close the gap but was too late. RIDAN'S MON disputed the pace two abreast and faded in the final furlong. PLEASE BE SEATED lacked the needed rally. GHOST WRESTLING failed to menace. CHIQUILINA tired. RIVER SALT saved ground disputing the pace to upper stretch and tired. GALLAPIAT'S FAME was outrun.
