DAVIDS LITTLE BOY circled horses leaving the far turn then ran down the leader. HIGHLY JUSTIN moved to engage for the lead with a three wide bid on the far turn then was not quite good enough for the winner. ST ANDREWS was unhurried early then responded well in the drive to close the gap. RAGING WILD FIRE disputed the pace racing two wide then drifted out at the top of the stretch. SOMBREADO prompted the pace and lacked the needed closing response. J DOUBLE F didn't break alertly then was forwardly placed and faded in the drive. MASON saved ground disputing the pace then weakened. TINDER LORD tired. MY ANGEL HARRIET showed little.
