CASA DE CAMBIO saved ground stalking the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and won clear under left handed urging. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueling leaving the second turn, came off the fence into the stretch, fought back to deep stretch and held second. TITIAN stalked between horses or outside a rival, bid alongside the runner-up leaving the second turn and between horses in the stretch and was edged for the place. HUSBAND'S FOLLY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. BEER MEISTER unhurried just off the rail then inside on the second turn, steadied in tight midway on that bend, came out in the stretch and improved position. GO TO THE PULPIT chased three deep or outside a rival, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. KING BILL angled in and settled outside a rival, found the rail on the second turn and was not a threat. SIR BELL lunged in a slow start and steadied, saved ground, advanced inside leaving the second turn, drifted out

in the stretch, was unsaddled a pole from the wire and vanned off. ALLEY HONDRO chased three deep, angled in on the second turn and gave way. MR PHALARIS stalked off the rail, dropped back between horses on the second turn and also gave way.
