SPRING UP had speed off the rail then stalked outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch to gain the lead and drew off under urging. WILDCAT CANDY got loose up the chute before the start, stalked outside then three deep to the stretch, drifted in and got up late for second. PROMISSORYEXCHANGE had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses leaving the turn, found the inside in the stretch and held third. IN A WINE TIZZY crowded early, settled outside a rival then inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for third. CHICAGO HERO sent between horses then was angled in on the backstretch, saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GRAND GAMBLER chased off the rail then between horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. BIG MACHER broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat. TUX off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also lacked the necessary response. ENTITLED PUNK crowded and forced in early, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail and did not rally. JIMMY THE WHIP had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, continued between rivals leaving the turn and weakened. SLIGHT EDGE between horses early, chased on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn and weakened. VALID BUT TRUE went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and had little left for the drive.
