### Footnotes

DIAMOND OF BLUE had good early speed and dueled off the rail, inched away on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and held on gamely under urging between foes late. ROYAL MERIDIAN settled just off the inside then angled in on the turn, swung out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and finished willingly to just miss. MAGIC BEAM chased inside then came off the rail on the turn, went four wide into the stretch and rallied gamely. LEGAL SEPARATION settled outside or off the rail, came out leaving the turn and six wide into the stretch and finished with interest. GUIDOPANZINI pulled early and stalked outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, loomed a threat four wide in midstretch and was outkicked. SIR ALLISON saved ground stalking the pace, loomed a threat a bit off the rail in midstretch and weakened late. CHASING THE HEAT chased outside a rival on the backstretch, came out some on the turn, swung out and steadied off heels five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PEACENIK dueled outside the winner, stalked leaving the turn, dropped back toward the inside in the stretch and weakened.
