KELA chased outside, went up four wide leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead and held gamely under left handed urging. YAZZERO (ARG) saved ground stalking the pace, split horses leaving the second turn, bid inside and continued gamely to the wire along the rail. TATE VENTURE (GB) settled outside a rival, moved up outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. THE PRICE SPIRIT stumbled at the start, settled a bit off the rail, also moved outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed third. BLACK MERCURY chased inside early, split horses on the backstretch, came out for the stretch and lacked the needed response. SPECIAL TIMES unhurried off the inside, came wide into the stretch and improved position. BARRON H allowed to settle a bit off the inside, dropped back on the backstretch and failed to menace. VALIANT WONDER close up between horses early, lugged out a bit into the first turn, chased the leader, was in a bit tight off heels in upper stretch and weakened. JUMP BAIL veered out sharply at the start, sped to the front and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled briefly leaving the second turn and had nothing left when headed.
