J AND S EXPRESS close up stalking the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch to gain the lead and won clear under urging. JOYCE AND ME broke in and slowly, was sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back off the rail into the stretch and between foes in upper stretch and held second. ADDENDUM stalked outside then alongside a rival, bid three deep on the turn, was floated four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. ROWDY GAL went up three deep to duel for the lead, battled between horses leaving the turn, also was floated out some into the stretch and weakened. QUINNETTE chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SECRET GENIUS settled off the pace inside, saved ground to the stretch to no avail. NO TRICKS FOR JACK had good early speed and duelled between horses, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
