Footnotes

FOOGARD saved ground stalking the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, bid along the rail past the eighth pole, gained the lead a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed under some late urging. SLEWPAY AGAIN stalked outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and went on willingly three wide on the wire. EXPONENTIALLY sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, inched away just off the rail into the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and also went on gamely late. ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN prompted the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, fell back some in the stretch, was trying to come on again late but was in a bit tight off heels nearing the wire. STORM REVELER fell back and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch then angled back in and improved position. WARRENS BACKNTOWN squeezed a bit at the start, chased between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. CHATTER UP stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. STORMIN also between horses early, chased off the rail, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. KHAL DROGO hesitated to be away behind the field, was sent up inside on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. ILLYBILLY BOY four wide early, chased outside a rival, drifted inward in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
