Footnotes

OLD MAN LAKE sped to the lead between horses, set the pace down the backstretch and around the turn, was challenged by the runner-up at the top of the lane, turned back that rival and drew clear to the wire. HE'S NOT TOO SHABY stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch, went after the winner on the turn, was turned back at the top of the lane and had to settle for second best. LAST EQUITY chased off the rail down the backstretch, moved closer between horses into the stretch, improved his position and was up late for the show. ONE FOR NOTHING stalked the pace on the inside, saved ground around the turn and was edged for the show at the wire. STATE CAPITAL stalked between horses on the backstretch, began to weaken on the turn, came into the lane three wide and gave way in the final furlong.
