Footnotes

ARABIAN STORM angled in and dueled outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under urging. IMPERIAL PRIDE chased between horses then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and gained the place. DEPUTIFORMER bumped at the start and again in the early going, settled a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and got up late for the show.

ITSSULTRYINTHECAPE broke in and bumped a rival then bumped again in the early running, settled off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late on the far outside. MARGARITA SHOT between foes early, stalked inside, waited off heels into the stretch, came a bit off the fence in the lane and lacked the needed late kick. FOREST COAST stalked three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. LIFE IS A ROCK settled inside, split horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and went between foes late. ORBACH stalked between horses then off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. AMERICAN WILDCAT had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. MY MAN SUMO chased between horses or outside a rival and did not rally. BRERETON PARK bumped between horses and steadied when squeezed at the start and again in the early stages, pulled between foes then off the rail, steadied again midway on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, waited off heels into the stretch and lacked a further response.
