### Footnotes

SURF N SKI stalked on the inside on the backstretch, moved up to reach even terms with the leader entering the turn, dueled on the inside around the turn, inched away in upper stretch and gamely held all rivals safe to the wire. CONGREGATIONALIST dueled inside a rival down the backstretch and outside the winner on the turn, could not match strides at the top of the lane, battled in the two path through the final furlong and held the place. SHINING SON bobbled at the start, chased on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, rallied three wide through the final furlong and just missed the place. ROCKY BARBOA dueled outside a rival down the backstretch and stalked off the rail on the turn, came into the lane between horses, battled four wide through the final furlong and lacked the needed rally. ORANGEYOUACUTIE stalked the pace off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane three wide, angled to the five path in the final furlong and was outfinished. WISE BOSS chased three wide into the turn, remained off the rail and weakened in the drive. LICO chased off the rail, swung out in the lane and did not pose a threat in the final furlong.
