GUNS LOADED had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back when briefly headed leaving the turn, regained the advantage and inched away late under urging. HI FASHIONED prompted the pace four wide then three deep on the turn, briefly put a head in front leaving the turn, battled outside the winner through the drive but could not match that one late and just held second. SOUTHERN FREEDOM chased inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and finished well. GLOBAL VIEW between rivals early, settled inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. INDEXICAL dueled between horses then steadied in tight early on the turn, continued outside a rival then came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. SHAKAHARI had speed off the rail then dueled three deep between foes, battled between rivals until midway on the turn, fell back and angled in and also weakened. WISDOM OF CROWDS chased between foes then was shuffled back in a bit tight midway on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. DOTHRAKI angled in and chased a bit off the rail, found the inside leaving the turn and weakened. KIMNJET broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace to the stretch and failed to menace.
