LINDSAY JEAN stalked the early pace outside a rival, bid between foes leaving the backstretch, dueled between horses into the turn, battled inside a rival but a bit off the rail on the bend, inched away and held gamely under urging. ROAM FREE settled off the rail then split foes on the backstretch, advanced on the turn and loomed a threat three deep into the stretch but could not catch the winner. VICTORIA'S CROWN settled a bit off the rail to the stretch, came out and picked up the show late. GREEN FLASH sped to the front off the rail, dueled three deep leaving the backstretch and into the turn, battled outside the winner on the bend, drifted inward in midstretch and weakened. WISH FOR A JEANNE stumbled badly at the start, settled off the inside and failed to menace. AIM FOR THE MOON went up inside to press the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. ROMANTIC ROAD chased outside or off the rail, came wide into the stretch and weakened.
