Footnotes

STORMY JACK unhurried inside early, came out on the turn, moved up three deep, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to a short lead past midstretch and held on gamely. LEXICON stalked the pace well outside rivals on the backstretch, made a quick move three deep in hand on the turn, took the lead leaving the bend, inched away, fought back between horses through the final furlong and went gamely to the wire. NATIONAL SAINT stalked the pace outside then off the rail on the turn, split horses in midstretch, bid inside the top pair and also went willingly to the end. MOST LIKELY (ARG) hopped in a bit of a slow start, settled outside a rival, went around a foe on the turn and lacked the needed response. MATEKA (FR) sped to a clear early lead, angled in on the backstretch, dueled inside leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. ALVO CERTO (BRZ) settled inside, steadied off heels leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, lacked the needed rally and took a bad step at the wire. HIGH WIRE ACT close up stalking the pace toward the inside, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
