ROMAN JAKE stalked outside, bid four wide into the stretch, gained a short lead and held gamely between foes. PROUD TOWER TOO dueled three deep then between horses into the stretch, fought back toward the inside and continued gamely to the end. TERRITORIAL settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch to loom a threat but could not get up. SLEWSBAG settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, steadied off heels when coming out in upper stretch and improved position. GENERALIST bumped and squeezed at the start, settled inside, split horses leaving the turn and also improved position. THIS WIZARD ROCKS bumped at the start, dueled between foes then inside into the stretch and weakened. C R POWER stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NICKEL SILVER wide early, stalked off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened. TIZ US bumped at the start, was sent between foes then chased a bit off the rail and did not rally. ELLIOT'S WAY broke slowly, settled off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and failed to menace. TRUE STRIDE bumped at the start, dueled inside, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. TRAILS NO ONE chased outside, dropped back between foes leaving the backstretch and gave way.
