Footnotes

NORTH FORK chased three deep around the first turn, remained three wide down the backstretch and around the second turn, came into the stretch four wide, put a head in front at the furlong marker and held to the wire. SKELLYTOWN raced between horses around the first turn, settled down the backstretch, moved up on the second turn to enter the lane five wide, rallied on the outside through the drive to be a clear second. MARQUET REBEL stalked on the outside down the backstretch, entered the lane three wide between horses, rallied, but had to settle for the show. JOE CARL stalked on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, was in tight and steadied while inside the tiring NO DREAM approaching the furlong marker and lost his best chance. NO DREAM moved up leaving the first turn to take the lead on the backstretch, led to the lane, came in and bumped JOE CARL at the furlong pole and weakened thereafter. HUNTER CREEK was without any early speed, chased to the lane and could not make up any ground. NATHANIEL sped to the early lead into the first turn, gave up the advantage on the backstretch, pressed the pacesetter to the second turn and fell back through the drive.
