Footnotes

AKKADIAN pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, drifted out at the top of the lane, remained well off the rail while taking the lead leaving the furlong marker and held to the wire. HOORAYFORHOLLYWOOD sped to the lead into the first turn, set the pace on the inside to the lane, battled back when challenged in midstretch held second. MASSONE was unhurried down the backstretch, chased off the rail, angled in for the stretch drive and gained the show in the final strides. BOXEUR DES RUES chased on the inside down the backstretch, steadied when in tight at the three eighths pole, was floated out a bit at the top of the lane, angled inside the winner in midstretch and was edged for the show. ALL SQUARED AWAY chased the pace off the rail, was asked to go after the leaders on the second turn, came into the stretch three wide, remained well off the rail though the lane and did not mount the necessary rally. SMOKE'N AL stumbled at the start and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling SMOKE'N AL was the cause of his own trouble.
