COSMIC HEAT stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied gamely under left handed urging, drifted in late, gained the lead approaching the wire and prevailed. CENTENARIO DE ORO prompted the pace four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch, took a short led outside a rival, fought back under urging between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly. FIGHTING ON pulled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, went between foes leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, rallied off the fence, tried to go between rivals in late stretch but steadied in tight. HEY YUP had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and went on willingly. HUSTLIN NU chased between horses then three deep on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. ROBIE THE CAT settled outside, went five wide on the turn, came out seven wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. BLUE COLLAR BOY saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch, came off the rail for room past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG HANDS AL chased between horses, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. HOOSIER DIDDY squeezed back at the start, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. FATHER PABST dueled between horses then outside a rival, battled between foes on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WARREN'S PAROLEE broke out, bumped a rival and steadied at the start, trailed off the rail throughout and failed to menace. VERY UNUSUAL stalked between horses, dropped back on the turn and weakened. Following a claim of foul by the rider of FIGHTING ON against the winner, the latter was disqualified and placed third for interference in late stretch.
