TATES CREEK angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid outside the pacesetter and took a short lead in midstretch, inched away and held under some urging. DESIRAES MY CANDY unhurried and angled in outside a rival early, moved up outside on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and gained the place late. CINDY'S HERO stalked along the inside, went outside the winner into and on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged late for second. LITTLE HOTTIE saved ground chasing the leader, came out in upper stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. BRISQUETTE pulled her way to the front and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back inside the winner in midstretch but was outfinished. MISS DOMUCH (IRE) settled three deep early then chased outside and had a mild late bid. STORM SAGA chased between horses then outside a rival, ranged up four wide leaving the second turn but could not sustain the bid. SHE'LL BE FIRST (FR) unhurried inside early, came out some on the second turn and did not rally. WHOOPDDOO fractious in the gate, settled outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also lacked a rally. GO RUBY GO close up tracking the leader inside then between horses on the second turn, drifted out leaving the bend and had little left.
