PRINCIPLE SECRET dueled three deep, took a short lead nearing midstretch and drew clear under a left handed crack of the whip and steady handling. HORSE GREELEY settled wide early then outside chasing the pace, continued off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. EDWARDIAN had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and to midstretch, was no match for the winner but lost second late. MARKED WARRIOR hopped slightly at the start, vied for command between horses to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SOLDIER chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAN LAW wide between foes early, settled off the inside chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. EL JUGADOR broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside chasing the pace to the stretch and weakened. MONTEREY JAZZ stalked off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. L. A. BOY dropped back inside on the backstretch without early speed, saved ground and was outrun.
