Footnotes

SAINTLY SPIRIT unhurried off the rail then a bit off the fence, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch, rallied under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. PROPHETISE a bit slow to begin, settled inside or a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and was second best. JET SET LASS had speed between foes then angled in and set the pace inside, kicked clear, drifted out in the stretch and bested the rest. SURE TIZ four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. NOT UNUSUAL chased a bit off the rail then between foes, split rivals on the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. RUBY

SLIPPERS stalked the pace outside then three deep, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. AFLEET'S PICASSO stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and weakened. DIXIE DOT CHANCE angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside, saved ground on the second turn and was not a threat. HANNAH'S MOMENT stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside in the stretch and weakened. ELEVENTH HOUR was in a good position stalking the pace between horses then a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes on the second turn and gave way. WHERE'S MY LIMO four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and also gave way.
