SILENCIO GATO chased outside then four wide into the turn, angled in and split horses leaving the turn, bid alongside a rival, gained the lead nearing midstretch, battled outside that one to deep stretch and inched away late under urging. LINK SUANCES sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. INCISIVE stalked outside a rival, lugged out on the turn and came six wide into the stretch but just missed second. JAKEY BOY chased just off the rail then inside to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHI CHA CHA pulled between horses then outside on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. JOHARDY broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail, came out into the stretch and improved position. MY T QUICK broke in and a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and six wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary late kick. PERSONALITARY chased between horses or off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out five wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed rally. RAMBO NATION squeezed back at the start, pulled alongside a rival then angled in and saved ground to no avail. PAPASON close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, weakened in the stretch. TEMPTING SOLUTION stalked between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. SUPERTEN broke in the air and slowly, was wide early then angled in between foes, dropped back and steadied midway on the turn, angled in entering the stretch and also weakened.
