Footnotes

IDONTROLLONSHABBOS dueled three deep around the turn, inched away at the top of the stretch, came in on a rival in midstretch and drew clear late. BUDS PAL veered in at the start, dueled between horses around the turn, steadied when the winner came over in midstretch and held the place at the wire. VALEN bobbed and was bumped at the start, moved up three deep around the turn, came into the stretch four wide and was up for the show in the late stages. ARIZONA WILDCAT veered out at the start, chased on the outside throughout the journey and improved his position in the final furlong. HEY PAULIE chased outside a rival into the turn, angled between horses in the lane and failed to make up the needed ground. GOYATHLA chased off the rail down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, steadied off heels in midstretch, came out for room and failed to rally. SPRING ROCKS chased inside a foe into the turn, came off the rail into the drive and did not rally. WHATS A REBAH veered in and bumped a foe at the start, dueled inside a three horse spread around the turn and weakened on the inside through the lane. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident in midstretch and ruled it did not alter the original order of finish.
