SMOKEY LONESOME saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and held gamely under urging. SEATTLE RULER angled in and stalked inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, took the lead three wide, fought back between horses in midstretch then inside the winner and continued willingly to the end. E Z LED saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, came out in upper stretch, split horses in deep stretch and gained the show late. GATHERATTHEALTER angled in outside a rival then chased inside, came out midway on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. SCORPION TIME chased outside a rival,

went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SPECIAL KID had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front leaving the second turn, battled between foes in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. QUAIL HILL sped between foes to the early lead, angled in and dueled inside, fought back leaving the second turn and until nearing midstretch, then weakened. ROMEO ROYALE settled outside a rival, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HUNTINGMAN broke outward, pulled his way along outside then stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened, then returned bleeding in the mouth. BUD I CRUSHED IT broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, trailed throughout and was not a factor.
